

Studio Indigo unveils ‘boomerang’ concept for luxury Moscow scheme

Designs for ‘prestigious’ 19,000 sqm site aim to maximise cathedral & river views without breaching stringent height restrictions.

London-based practice Studio Indigo has been called up to design a “prestigious” apartment scheme in Moscow.

The firm has come up with a “boomerang” concept for the 19,000 square metre site near the Moskva River, which gives all 100 units views of the city, including the river and the Christ Our Saviour Cathedral, without breaching stringent height restrictions.



A “richly detailed” stone façade will feature touches of bronze, and the plans include a courtyard and communal gardens, residents’ spa and health facilities, and prime boutique retail stores. Top-tier units include a set of penthouses - with roof terrace access - and two

large villas.

Unveiling the concept, the firm said: “The result is an elegant and dynamic design that responds to the city’s vernacular whilst maximising the stunning cityscape view with the addition of green spaces and retail shops.”
